Creating

Explore

Plan

Express

- a Identify and demonstrate directions for moving the body in general space (for example, forward, backwards, sideways, up, down, and turning) and finding and returning to a place in space. DA:PR4.1.A.PK
- b Identify speed of dance as fast or slow. Move to varied rhythmic sounds at different tempi. DA:PR4.1.B.PK
- c Move with opposing characteristics (for example, loose/tight, light/heavy, jerky/smooth). DA:PR4.1.C.PK
